Managers are to publish a starting and ending time for the Open Pit and, in addition, a starting time for the Final jumps. Only one entrance to the long jump runway is to be available to contestants. Managers will define for visiting coaches the restricted and unrestricted areas.

Regionals using FAT will eliminate one round of competition in the 110m/100m Hurdles, 100m Dash and the 200m Dash. The first round for these events will be conducted following the 3200m Relay (1st running event).

ADDITIONAL INFORMATION

ADMISSION: Spectator Gates will open at <u>11:30 a.m.</u> All Regional sites require a \$6.00 admission charge for non-participating athletes, students and adults, including bus drivers. League/Season passes CAN NOT be honored.

SPECTATOR PARKING: All parking will be available outside of the fences in the athletic stadium area. Handicap parking is available close to both entrance gates. Spectators are expected to park in designated parking spots.

WARM-UPS: The track/infield will be available for warm-up activity until 10:45 AM at which time all participants must clear the area for competition. The track will be available during the break before FINALS until 2:30 PM. NO WARM-UPS WILL TAKE PLACE IN THE FIELD EVENT AREAS UNTIL SUPERVISED!

LOCKER ROOMS: Showers/Lockers will not be available to participants.

TEAM PARKING: Team busses/vans should park at the south west corner of the main parking lot.

TEAM CAMPS: Team tents/gatherings may not be set up on the infield of the track. They may be set up outside the perimeter of the track. Please <u>DO NOT</u> hang hammocks or any other items on any of the fences. Teams are responsible for removing all trash from their areas before leaving the facility. Thank you for your cooperation.


SECURITY: Remind your athletes to not leave bags unattended.
