## Fall Tournament Good Sports Are Winners! Recipients Announced; Little Caesars Pizza To Present Awards To Over 400 Schools;

EAST LANSING, Mich. -- Dec. 20 -- The recipients of the top Michigan High School Athletic Association's Good Sports Are Winners! Awards for the recently-completed 2000 fall sports season have been named, with each school to receive commemorative banners, crystal trophies and a $\$ 1,000$ donation from Little Caesars Pizza, the Association's corporate partner in sportsmanship efforts.

Allen Park Inter-City Baptist in boys soccer, Schoolcraft in football and DeWitt in girls basketball, were selected by the tournament management at their respective finals for displaying the most exemplary sportsmanship by their coaches, student-athletes and spectators. Presentation dates at all three schools will be announced at a future date.

Allen Park Inter-City Baptist was the champion in the Division 4 boys soccer tournament; Schoolcraft was the runner-up in the Division 6 football playoffs; and DeWitt was a semifinalist in the Class B girls basketball tournament.

In addition to receiving the finals award, Schoolcraft was honored at the district and regional levels of the football playoffs. DeWitt is being honored with a finals level award for the third time, the previous occasions being at the 1989 Football Finals and the 1996 Baseball Finals.

The Good Sports Are Winners! Award is making its return in 2000-01 with the corporate underwriting of Little Caesars Pizza. The program had previously been offered from 1989 to 1996.

Major changes have been made as the program returns. At the district and regional level of MHSAA tournaments, all schools which meet a set of sportsmanlike standards will receive awards, which will result in nearly 500 additional schools being recognized annually. Previously, the award was presented to only one school at each tournament center. There have also been standards introduced into the program which would automatically disqualify a school from consideration from the award. Any team which is disqualified for the Good Sports Are Winners! Award at the District or Regional level of a tournament becomes ineligible for the award at higher levels of that same tournament.

## 2-2-2 - Fall Good Sports Are Winners! Recipients

In all, 203 teams in girls basketball, 123 in football and 85 in boys soccer will receive either certificates at the district level, or plaques at the regional level from Little Caesars Pizza during fall competition. During the course of the 2000-01 school year, nearly 1,500 awards will be presented, recognizing schools in ten activities for their sportsmanship efforts during MHSAA tournaments.

The MHSAA is a private, not-for-profit corporation of voluntary membership by over 1,300 public and private senior high schools and junior high/middle schools which exists to develop common rules for athletic eligibility and competition. No government funds or tax dollars support the MHSAA, which was the first such association nationally to not accept membership dues or tournament entry fees from schools. Member schools which enforce these rules are permitted to participate in MHSAA tournaments which attract approximately 1.6 million spectators each year.

Little Caesars Pizza, founded in 1959 by Michael and Marian Ilitch, is an international pizza chain with locations on 5 continents. The Ilitch family has been a proud sponsor of amateur sports since 1964. The Little Caesars amateur sports program started with the sponsorship of one hockey team, and today more than 17,000 children participate in Little Caesars sponsored sports throughout the community.
