20-30-40 Year Officials Honored At Officials' Awards & Alumni Banquet On May 10

EAST LANSING, Mich. – **April 22** – The Michigan High School Athletic Association's annual Officials' Awards & Alumni Banquet will honor 289 individuals with 20 or more years of service to the interscholastic sports community.
