## Lutheran Westland, Petoskey, Ubly Take Top Sportsmanship Awards For Fall Tournaments; MEEMIC Insurance To Honor All Recipients

**EAST LANSING, Mich.** – **Jan. 16** -- Nearly 200 teams representing over 150 schools have been selected to be recognized for displaying outstanding sportsmanship during selected Fall Michigan High School Athletic Association postseason tournament competitions through the Good Sports Are Winners! Boyne City was recognized in the fall at three tournaments, while 17 schools received mention in twice.
