Football Discussion 11-Player/8-Player

- 1. The Representative Council will review and vote on the proposed strength of schedule plan to the MHSAA tournament qualification process. If approved, it would start in 2020.
- 2. Some UP schools have concerns about scheduling Kingsford, Escanaba, Marquette, Gladstone and Menominee in football. These schools have been forced to scramble for games, given the formation of the West Pac League of 15 schools. Schools of the Great Northern UP Conference will lose game consideration form Wisconsin schools which are moving to closed border schedules in 2020.

With some forward thinking and especially if the strength of schedule format is approved, it may seem feasible for the West Pac league to incorporate Kingsford, Gladstone and Menominee while Escanaba and Marquette could become scheduling partners with the Big North Conference.

These transitions will have to overcome concerns of strength of program (Menominee) and travel distances to Escanaba and Marquette.

There is also the possibility that the Wisconsin League will offer contests to Kingsford HS.

Additional Discussion Items

- 1. Internet Conference Exploration The committee discussed the potential of video-conference opportunities given developing technologies. The committee will explore such possibilities in future meetings.
- 2. Basketball Four Quarter Proposal
 The committee reviewed a request that would allow students in grades 9-12 to participate
 on multiple teams on any given day (to play on both the JV and varsity basketball teams on
 the same day), however, being limited to no more than four total quarters in one day.
 The committee suggest that further discussion is warranted and recommended that this
 topic to be placed on the Basketball Regulation Committees agenda.
- 3. The committee reaffirms that for <u>all</u> Upper Peninsula basketball Districts will utilize the established non-traditional format unless <u>all</u> schools assigned to a specific District agree to the traditional format.
