### **ENROLLMENT LISTINGS FOR UPPER PENINSULA SCHOOLS**

The committee reviewed the 2010-11 enrollment listing and Division list for all current member schools and specifically for Upper Peninsula schools. The committee made note of Upper Peninsula schools that changed classification and those that are involved in cooperative programs.

#### **UPPER PENINSULA TOURNAMENTS AND NON-TRADITIONAL DRAWS**

MHSAA staff provided the committee with a document prepared to clarify any future discussions relating to the authority of the committee for expanding Non-Traditional Draws.

Currently, Representative Council policy mandates Non-Traditional Draws for some specific Districts of both volleyball and basketball and the Representative Council allows Non-Traditional Draws everywhere else. However, it would not be appropriate for the Upper Peninsula Athletic Committee to require Non-Traditional Draws for additional Districts for volleyball, but not girls basketball; or for girls basketball, but not boys basketball without expressed permission from the Representative Council.

#### **DISCUSSION ITEMS**

The committee discussed at length the opportunities for Non-Traditional Draws used in basketball, volleyball and potentially in hockey. Discussions centered on the Districts that are currently mandated to use the Non-Traditional Draw format and the need for other Districts to have complete agreement of assigned schools in order to use the option of the Non-Traditional Draw.

The committee will discuss with the Upper Peninsula athletic directors the possibility of allowing tournament sites to choose the Non-Traditional Draw format if the majority of assigned schools agree, rather than all.

The committee also discussed the possible use of Zone 7 (Northern Lower Peninsula) officials on the eastern end of the Upper Peninsula for tournaments, noting a shortage of officials in that area and the same officials being assigned to the same Districts year after year. MHSAA staff will attempt to provide a list of approved officials in Zone 7 that might have interest and availability to work Upper Peninsula sites.
