Parking:

We will be charging \$10 per car as you enter South Christian per the MHSAA guidelines for Regional XC. We will have additional spectator parking at Cornerstone Church if our lot fills up (1675 84th St SE, Caledonia, MI 49316). There will be a shuttle bus available to take spectators from Cornerstone to South Christian and will be provided both ways as needed. Please do not park in the neighborhoods around South Christian and only in the designated parking areas.

Bus Parking:

We will park as many team buses as we can at designated areas on our campus at South Christian HS. It is possible that you might have to park a bus in the overflow lot at Cross Creek Charter Academy which is a short distance from our school (7701 Kalamazoo Ave SE, Byron Center, MI 49315). We will have a shuttle van for the bus drivers to be driven to South Christian as needed. Please let us know when you plan to arrive for our event and how many buses or vans you are bringing.

Team Tents:

All team tents will go up on our main soccer field which is the field where the race begins on your map below.

Course Markings and Maps:

Our course is clearly marked with red (Mile 1), white (Mile 2) and blue (Mile 3) lines throughout.

After the Race/Medals:

We will have our athletic trainer near the finish line as needed along with volunteers to help athletes move through the chute as quickly as possible. The awards presentation will take place on our soccer field in front of the bleachers and will begin at approximately 10:00am after all results are in.
