Entries

- In accordance with MHSAA policy, all entries must be submitted via Athletic.net **NO LATER than Saturday, October 19th @ 8:00 p.m.** Please enter **ONLY** your top **9** athletes.
- Late entries A \$50 late fee must be paid for all entries submitted after the entry deadline. Late fee checks should be made out to Romeo High School Athletics. Once starting positions are set by Wednesday, October 23...No late entries will be accepted.
- Master eligibility lists or Opt-Outs must be sent <u>NO LATER</u> than Friday, October 11th to confirm participation. The Mhsaa needs to be contacted for Opt-Outs. Master Eligibility lists can be sent to Kerry Wendt at: <u>kerry.wendt@romeok12.org</u>

Timing, Scoring & Results

- Timing will be done using a FinishLynx FAT system and/or RFID tags. Brad Fairchild from Fairchild Sports Timing will be our timer throughout the day.
- Packets will be available for pick-up at the finish line.
- Bibs Bibs are to be pinned in all four corners. Do not alter the bib, including wrinkling. Bibs need to be clearly visible during the race.
- We will post unofficial results outside of the finish line trailer. Please check the unofficial results within the 15 minutes of posting, before they become official. Verify that all of your runners are on the results.
- Live and official results will be posted on athletic.net. We will be using the A-Net Live platform.

Admission and Spectators

There will be a \$7.00 admission for all spectators in attendance. Tickets can be purchased prior through GO Fan at the following link. Please encourage spectators to purchase tickets early as it will ease congestion entering the facility. **GO FAN LINK**

All Spectators should be stationed behind set-up barriers, and the double line to avoid interfering with the athletes racing. **Per MHSAA rules, NO DOGS are allowed at MHSAA events.** Thanks in advance.

The Goodells Course

Non repeating course that has a variety of open field running, a wooded section, and rolling hills the last mile. The course will be double lined throughout, and every turn barriered with flags and natural barriers. There will be a lead vehicle for all races (weather pending), and meet personal at the turns.

The course will be lined and open for full review by Thursday, October 24th at 3:00 p.m. until meet day. Keep in mind, the SC4 Conference championships will be running on Friday, so please plan accordingly if you plan to review the course on Friday.

Every 1k and 1m will be marked throughout the course, and the course will be wheel measured at the shortest path taken. Labeled markings will include: 1000m, 1 mile, 2000m, 3000m, 2 mile, 4000m, 3 mile, 5k. There will be running time clocks at the 1 mile and 2 mile locations.

Prom Races

We will be offering a PROM race (Post Regional Open Meet) to all attending schools. There is a \$150 per school entry (\$75 per gender). Enter your athletes on Athletic.net under Post Regional Open Meet (PROM) race, it is a separate race that you'll need to register for in anet. This race will only be open to registered athletes and is separate from the MHSAA Regional. Entry fee's will go towards extra accrued meet management and site fees.

Awards

- The awards ceremony will be held at the main stage area just north of the barns. We look to get this started right at the conclusion of the Girls PROM Race (12:30 p.m.)
- Medals to top 15 individuals in each race. Trophies to first place teams in each race. 7 team medals for each runner on the championship teams.

State Qualifiers

- Top three teams advance to the MHSAA Finals.
- Any individual finishing in the top 15 qualifies for the MHSAA Finals. If less than 7 individual qualifiers are in the top 15, then the next best individuals not on a qualifying team will fill the remaining 7 individual qualifying spots.
- A 4th place team can qualify, if there are 8 or more scoring teams, and if the 4th place team has 4 or more finishers in the top 20 individuals. The maximum number of teams qualifying from a regional cannot exceed four.
- If your team or individuals qualify for the MHSAA Finals, please make sure that you pick up the State info packet at the conclusion of the regional meet awards ceremony. Information will not be mailed. Finals information can be found on MHSAA.com.

If an appeal involves a school from the games committee, an alternate will be selected.

Parking
