TIME SCHEDULE:

Friday, November 18

9:30 am O'rena Ticket Office and doors to the spectator area open on third floor.
"Officials and Participants" doors will open. They are located on the back side of the O'rena marked as loading dock entrance. You will go through the 3 glass doors into the building.
Registration will be on the 1st floor of the building (pool level).

10 am – 11:45 am Swimming and Diving Warm-ups.

11:45 am Clear pool/boards

12:00 - 3:30 pm (approx.) Swimming prelims. Diving boards will remain open at this time.
Diving preliminaries will commence immediately following the last heat of the 400 Free Relay

Saturday, November 19

9:30am Facility opens to competitors and coaches

10:00am-11:45am Swimming and Diving warm-ups commence

12:00pm-5:00pm Swimming & Diving Finals

RULES:

M.H.S.A.A. rules will apply according to National Federation (Current Edition). During the Prelims session, there will be a 15 minute break between the last heat of the 50 Yard Freestyle and the first heat of the 100 Yard Butterfly. Additionally, during Both Prelims/Finals session, there will be a 10 minute break after the 200 Yard Medley Relay. There will a heat of the 50 Freestyle Paralympic exhibition and a heat of the 100 Freestyle Paralympic exhibition conducted immediately prior to the Diving Finals.

ENTRIES:

All swim entries are due **Monday, November 14th, by Noon**. ALL entries must be in Hy-Tek format (meet file available at MHSAA.com, software available on the Hy-Tek website). Please send Hy-Tek entries to: entriesd1@gmail.com. Please include an emergency phone number and contact information. ALL entries should include first and last name, grade (in number format...9-10-11-12). Use the school abbreviations supplied on the MHSAA website. Final diving entries will be made via the official eDive results from Regionals. **PLEASE INCLUDE DIVERS QUALIFYING FOR REGIONALS IN YOUR HY-TEK TEAM DATABASE SENT BY Monday, November 14th so we can remove them if not qualified for Championships.**

ALTERNATES:

• Due to facility capacity and protocol, relay-only swimmers will be limited to those participating in the event. Each team is allowed a maximum of 3 alternates. Those alternates may be listed in each of the three relays. Athletes entered in individual events will not count toward relay-only swimmers and may be listed on relays in accordance with NFHS rules. Each team is allowed a maximum of 3 alternates. Those alternates may be listed in each of the three relays.

*Athletes who are entered in individual events may also be listed as relay alternates that do not count toward the three alternate maximum (as they are already on deck).

SWIMMING CONFIRMATION PROCEDURE:

- A. All entries are due by 12:00 pm the Monday before the state meet
- B. Coaches are warned to use a non-school email to prevent firewall issues, etc.
- C. Coaches must include
 1. Coaches contact info: Phone number and email address
 2. Appropriate MHSAA school name/abbreviation from MHSAA website-check MHSAA & MISCA Sites for up to date info.
(All codes are updated for use with Hy-tek)
 3. List Numeric Grades for all athletes
 4. Appropriate/verifiable seed time
- D. By 12:00 pm, Tuesday, state meet hosts will email back confirmation of receipt of entries and an entry report from what they receive.
- E. Coaches have until 9:00 pm, Tuesday to reply with any corrections to entry report – MAY BE SUBJECT TO \$50 LATE FEE at Meet Manager’s discretion.
- F. Psych sheet will be posted on the MHSAA website by 12:00 pm, Wednesday.
NO CHANGES TO ENTRIES WILL BE ALLOWED AFTER 12:00 PM, WEDNESDAY.
- G. Psych sheets will include relay names including alternates.

DIVING CONFIRMATION PROCEDURE:

- A. All divers will be automatically entered into the State Meet via Regional Results. ALL divers must be listed in the Hy-Tek Entry File sent by swim coaches by Monday November 14th if they are diving Regionals.
- B. Diving sheets will not be included in the Meet Packet which coaches will receive at check-in Friday.
- C. An anticipated start time for diving is **IMMEDIATELY AFTER THE 400 FREE RELAY**. Therefore, confirmation and signing of final dive sheets must be made at the Diving Scoring Table, with the Diving Manager prior to 2:30 on Friday.
- D. No diving sheets should be faxed to Meet Management prior to the meet. All Diving sheets will be generated on-site via eDive.

ADMISSIONS:

- A. All tickets are digital and available through GoFan and must be presented at the main entrance of the O'rena. For more info visit <https://gofan.co/app/school/MHSAA>
- B. Friday Prelims: \$11
- C. Saturday Finals: \$11
- D. No outside chairs/seats allowed inside the facility

PROGRAMS:

- \$5 per program

CONCESSIONS:

- There will be a concession stand located on the 3rd level in the O'rena
- No outside food will allowed to be brought into the facility

WARM-UP & COOL-DOWN:

- Swimmers may warm-up and cool-down on the South side of the bulkhead in the lanes provided.

DECK PASSES: (COACHES PLEASE READ!)

- Deck passes will be issued to all qualifying athletes, by the host and must be visible at all times.
- Per MHSAA policy, only two (2) coaches' passes per team will be issued, **(three (3) if a diver has qualified)**. No manager pass will be issued for teams with less than 5 qualifiers. Extra coaches or manager passes can be purchased by the head coach only for \$20 per pass at the registration table. Receipts will be provided upon request.
- Note: Athlete Deck Passes may not be used for access into the spectator seating area

PARKING (Please see attached maps):

Friday, November 18th and Saturday, November 19th

- All buses and school vans should park in the parking lot P13 or P35
- Reminder: Classes will be in session and all illegally parked vehicles will be ticketed

T-SHIRT/APPAREL SALES:

- Apparel vendors will be located on the third floor of the O'rena

IMPORTANT FACILITY NOTES

Oakland University Athletics and Aquatic Center Rules will be enforced at all times.

NO CHAIRS (Chairback seats that clip onto bleachers are OK provided they are no wider than 18")

NO coolers or food brought into the facility. Concessions will be available.

NO video or camera tripods.

NO extension cords or battery chargers.

NO helium balloons.

NO taping of signs or team banners in facility except in designated area only.

NO shaving down of any kind in facility.

NO parking of buses or usage by buses in drop-off area in front of O'rena.

NO entrance into the swimming venue from the Recreation building entrance. **OU students only.**

NO noise makers or flash photography.

NO signs, posters, banners, etc. may be posted in the lobby or outside the building as these are considered *neutral sites*.

Parking permitted in all lots on a first come first serve basis. Lot's 11, 16, 17, 18, 26 along with the parking structure (P29) are the closest options. School is in session on Friday and parking will be limited. People parking in unauthorized areas will be ticketed. **OU Athletics reserves the right to reserve parking areas for other simultaneous events in the building if necessary**

Athletes and coaches only will be allowed to enter through from the "**Participant & Officials**" doors located off the loading dock entrances in back of the O'rena.

Team Registration will begin on Friday morning on Level 1 of the natatorium starting at 9:30 AM.

Participant passes must be visible at all times.

Only two coaches (2) passes per team will be issued (per MHSAA). Extra coaches or manager passes can be purchased for \$20 per pass at the registration table. Receipts will be provided.

Bleacher seating will be provided on the pool deck for team use. Teams are responsible to clean up their area before leaving the facility.

Seating in the upstairs bleachers will be available on a first come first serve basis. Saving seats is NOT allowed. Do NOT sit in the stairways; this is considered a fire hazard.

- **From I-75**
I-75 to Exit 79 (University Drive)
East about one mile to Squirrel Road
- **From Telegraph Road**
Telegraph Road to Square Lake Road
To I-75 North Exit 79 (University Drive)

- **From M-59 East** (from Pontiac)
M-59 past Wide Track Drive
